The children have enjoyed their continued work on the Three Little Pigs this week. We shared the story of the 'Wolf's Tale' and it was interesting to hear that many children now consider the Wolf to be a good character who was only trying to make friends with the pigs! The children have also made the Three Little Pigs houses to test which material is the best to build a house from. The children made their houses from straw, sticks and bricks and we tested the houses with a hairdryer as we didn't have a big bad wolf to hand!

As part of our new RE 'Celebration' topic the children have been learning about objects found in church which are used in celebrations. To help the children to understand about these special objects, we visited church on Thursday to find them in a Treasure Hunt.

The children have also been looking at which numbers they can make by adding two numbers from 1 to 5 together. The children have used the numicon shapes to do this. These activities can be repeated at home using counters as the children are now able to create the numicon shapes using counters. I have copied a set of the numicon shapes so that you can see how the number patterns are arranged for each number.


Next week the children will be looking at different homes from around the world. They will also be looking at simple maps.
