



Science- Plants and Animals

Children will be taught to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will also find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

English

The children will learn about weather around the World by following the adventures of Sonny the Meerkat in Meerkat Mail

The children will create poems using their senses with the trip to the seaside as a stimulus.

We will use the 'Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' as a basis to write our own stories focussing on the use of story language

Mathematics

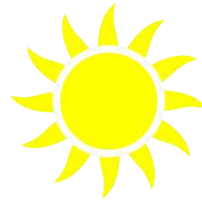
The children will be consolidating the strategies to add, subtract, multiply and divide and apply them in problem solving contexts.

We will learn about fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$. The children will learn how to find fractions of shapes and numbers.

We will learn to tell the time to five minutes using analogue clocks and solve time word problems.

We will also learn to measure capacity and volume. Towards the end of the year the children will practice their problem solving skills through visual and logic problems.
