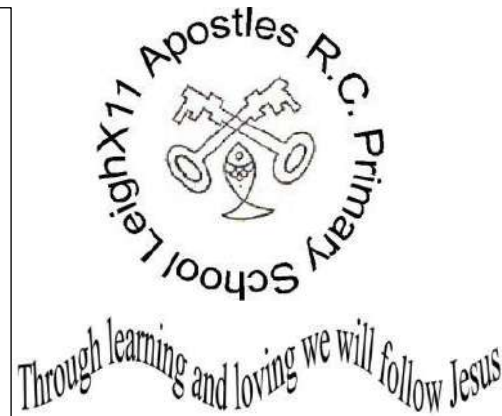


English

This term, the children will write a recount of the life of an Anglo Saxon soldier and a mythical narrative about a Norse God. They will also work on their speaking and listening skills through drama and poetry. They will continue to master their literary skills they have been working hard on all year; preparing them for the challenges of the Year 5 curriculum next year.



Mathematics

The children will master their skills in geometry this term. Learning all about shapes, symmetry, angles, area and perimeter! They will also work on their statistics; presenting and interpreting data in a variety of ways. We will also have the chance to test our problem solving skills throughout the term.
