We'll also be extending our range of punctuation, and be including hyphens, colons and semi colons in our work.

After SATs will be looking at the work of one of the most famous play writes, Mr William Shakespeare. We will also be writing persuasively as part of our Enterprise project.

Maths

During the first part of the term, our preparations for SATs will continue, so we'll be focusing on practising and applying all our maths skills and our test techniques. After SATs, we'll be applying our mathematical knowledge to become business tycoons as we prepare for our Enterprise project. There will be lots of problem solving and budget managing. We'll also be having a maths's themed week which will involve lots of problem solving too...as well as fun!

Science

We will be continuing to learn about light and how we see things, and developing our scientific skills. In the second half of the term, we'll be learning about the circulatory system and how the heart works. This involves understanding what harms our bodies and how we can keep fit and healthy.

We'll be taking a whirlwind tour of our world, visiting some of the continents and learning about some of the countries within them. As this is your last term in primary school, one of our main topics will be 'Growing Up and Moving On'.
